## Distribution and Habitat

Bindoon to Israelite Bay, growing in sandy, sandy-clay and lateritic soils in forests, woodlands and shrublands.

## Description

A distinctive **species** 120–350 mm high with a hairy leaf 100–250 mm long by 15–25 mm wide and up to three red, yellow and green flowers 30–50 mm across.

## Distinguishing Features

The **species** is readily distinguished from other members of the **complex** by its erect **petals**.
