## Distribution and Habitat

Perth to Albany, growing in sandy, sandy-clay and lateritic soils in forests, woodlands and shrublands.

## Flowering Months

## Description

A lower south-western **subspecies** with a hairy leaf 60–150 mm long by 5–10 mm wide and up to two green, yellow and red flowers 50–70 mm across.

## Distinguishing Features

It is distinguished from the other **subspecies** by its larger flowers, broader **labellum** and lower south-west distribution, rather than east of Jerramungup.
