North of Port Gregory, growing in sandy-clay and clay soils in a seasonally wet flat.

Description

A rare, localised **species** 120–250 mm high with a hairy leaf 30–90 mm long by 3–7 mm wide and up to two bright white flowers 50–80 mm across.

Distinguishing Features

It is distinguished from most other members of the *Caladenia filamentosa* **complex** which have two single, well-spaced longitudinal rows of **labellum lamina calli** in usually having **calli** in two groups of rows each comprising two indistinct longitudinal rows.
