## Distribution and Habitat

Yallingup to Forest Grove, growing in sandy-clay and lateritic soils in forests and woodlands.

## Description

An uncommon **species** 300–600 mm high with a hairy leaf 100–250 mm long by 4–10 mm wide and up to three pale yellow to greenish-yellow flowers 60–90 mm across.

## Distinguishing Features

It is distinguished from the other members of the *Caladenia longicauda* **complex** by its pale yellow to greenish-yellow flowers and short **labellum fringe segments**.
