## Distribution and Habitat

Kojonup to Frankland with a disjunct populations at Quindanning and West Dale, growing in sandy-clay and lateritic soils in open woodlands.

## Flowering Months

## Description

A rare [species](#) 100–250 mm high with a hairy leaf 60–100 mm long by 3–7 mm wide and up to three white to yellowish-white flowers 25–30 mm across. The [labellum](#) may be [entire](#) or have [serrate fringe segments](#).

## Distinguishing Features

It is distinguished from all other members of the *Caladenia filamentosa* [complex](#) by its prominently downcurved [petals](#) and [sepals](#), the latter crossing in front of the [ovary](#), and its [labellum](#) with widely spaced [fringe segments](#) and prominent irregular spots and blotches.
