## Distribution and Habitat

Mingenew to Ravensthorpe, growing in sandy and sandy-clay soils in woodlands and shrublands. The [species](#) is particularly common on sandy rises above salt lakes.

## Description

A common wheatbelt [species](#) 100–300 mm high with a hairy leaf 50–150 mm long by 4–6 mm wide and one (rarely two) greenish to greenish-yellow and red flowers 15–30 mm across.

## Distinguishing Features

It is distinguished from all other members of the *Caladenia roei* [complex](#) by its long [lateral sepals](#) that terminate in small [apical](#) clubs.
