Distribution and Habitat

Manypeaks (town) to Israelite Bay, growing in sandy, sandy-clay and granitic soils in woodlands and shrublands.

Description

A self-pollinating [species](#) 150–350 mm high with a almost hairless leaf 100–180 mm long by 5–8 mm wide and up to two greenish-white and pale red flowers 30–50 mm across.

Distinguishing Features

It is distinguished from other members of the *Caladenia hoffmanii* [complex](#) by its self pollinating flowers and narrowly pointed [labellum](#) apex.
