Distribution and Habitat

Boddington to Quindanning, growing in sandy-clay soil on the edges of seasonally wet flats and watercourses.

Description

A distinctive, recently named [species](#) 200–350 mm high with a hairy leaf 70–150 mm long by 2–10 mm wide and up to four creamy-yellow and white flowers 40–50 mm across.

Distinguishing Features

It is distinguished from the other members of the *Caladenia longicauda* [complex](#) by its small flowers, often crossed [lateral sepals](#) and short [labellum fringe segments](#).
