Distribution and Habitat

Jurien Bay to Israelite Bay, growing in sandy and sandy-clay soils in seasonally wet flats and runoff areas on granite outcrops. Although the <u>species</u> flowers best in the season following summer fire it may also be seen flowering in lower numbers in other years.

Description

A common <u>species</u> 80-100 mm high with a hairy leaf, 40-80 mm long by 12-15 mm wide , which is usually green on the underside and up to four creamy-white (rarely pinkish) flowers 20-30 mm across.
