## Description

A recently recognised <u>species</u> 220–400 mm high with a hairy leaf 50–200 mm long by 6–13 mm wide and up to three creamy-white, green to yellowish-green suffused flowers 70–100 mm across.

## Distinguishing Features

It is distinguished from the similar White Spider orchid (Caladenia longicauda) by its shorter <u>petals</u>, <u>clubbed sepals</u> and regularly having up to eight rows of <u>labellum lamina calli</u> (C. longicauda usually has between four and six rows).
