Distribution and Habitat

North of Kellerberrin, growing in seasonally damp sandy-clay soil above drainage lines in open Eucalyptus woodland.

Flowering Months

Description

A geographically restricted [species](#) 200-300 mm high with a hairy leaf 60–120 mm long by 2–4 mm wide and up to three blood-red, pinkish-red or creamy white flowers with maroon stripes and blotches 50-70 mm across; floral odour faint, like burning metal.

Distinguishing Features

It is distinguished from the related Blood Spider Orchid (*Caladenia filifera*) by its slightly smaller variably coloured flowers, [petals](#) and [lateral sepals](#) curving obliquely downwards (c.f. [pendulous](#)), its shorter [petals](#), its smaller [labellum](#) and its usually shorter [column](#) and inland range of distribution.
