## Distribution and Habitat

Pingelly to west of York, growing in sandy and sandy-clay soils in forests and woodlands.

## Flowering Months

## Description

A rare [species](#) 120–250 mm high with a hairy leaf 70–130 mm long by 3–5 mm wide and up to two creamy-white to creamy-yellow flowers 50–80 mm across.

## Distinguishing Features

It is similar in appearance to Brookton Highway Spider Orchid (*Caladenia fluvialis*) but is generally smaller flowered and has less stiffly held [petals](#) and [sepals](#). It also prefers dryer soils in more upland [habitat](#).
