Description

A distinctive **subspecies** 200–300 mm high with a hairy leaf 80–150 mm long by 7–10 mm wide and up to three creamy-white to yellowish-cream flowers 40–60 mm across.

Distinguishing Features

Unlike the typical **subspecies** the **labellum** lacks a red tip.
