Distribution and Habitat

Forrestania to Balladonia, growing in sandy and sandy-clay soils in shrublands and woodlands. In the north-eastern part of its range the [species](#) occupies soil pockets on granite outcrops.

Description

An uncommon [species](#) 80–100 mm high with a hairy leaf 50–150 mm long by 4–6 mm wide and one (rarely two) greenish-yellow and red flowers 15–20 mm across.

Distinguishing Features

It is distinguished from the related Crested Spider Orchid (*Caladenia cristata*) by its slightly larger less darkly marked flowers, broader [labellum](#), thicker [lamina calli](#) and easterly range of distribution.
