### Distribution and Habitat

Mullewa to Kalbarri, growing in sandy soils in woodlands and shrublands.

### Flowering Months

### Description

A northern [species](#) 120–200 mm high with a hairy leaf 30–80 mm long by 2–4 mm wide and up to two creamy-white, prominently red-stripped flowers 30–40 mm across.

### Distinguishing Features

It is superficially similar to members of the *Caladenia filamentosa* [complex](#) but is readily distinguished from them by its [clubbed sepals](#).
