Hyden to Balladonia, growing in sandy-clay soils in woodlands and shrublands.

Description

A diminutive **hybrid** 100–150 mm high with a dull green, prominently hairy leaf 30–70 mm long by 2–3 mm wide and up to two creamy-white to pale yellow, red-marked flowers 20–30 mm across.

A hybrid between Western Wispy Spider Orchid (*Caladenia microchila*) and Sigmoid Spider Orchid (*C. sigmoidea*).
