Description

Corunastylis [species](#) have a slender, smooth leaf, a smooth flowering stem and up to 50 small flowers in a dense [spike](#). Like the leek orchids (Prasophyllum) flowers are inverted with the [labellum](#) above, rather than below the [column](#).

Distinguishing Features

However, in Corunastylis the [lateral sepals](#) are always widely separated rather than usually being united and the [inflorescence](#) emerges from near the top of the leaf rather than part way down.
