Description

Cyanicula <u>species</u> have a hairy leaf, a hairy flowering stem and up to three (rarely four) flowers. There are two basic flower shapes, those with a narrow, prominently tri-lobed <u>labellum</u> and those with a broad, flattened <u>labellum</u> that lacks <u>lateral</u> lobes. Cyanicula <u>species</u> are similar to the Sun Orchids (Thelymitra) in that many have temperature sensitive flowers that open during warm weather but remain partially closed in cool, cloudy weather.
