## Description

An early flowering  $\underline{\text{species}}$  180–300 mm high with two to three smooth leaves 80–200 mm long by 3–8 mm wide and up to six yellow, brown and mauve flowers 25–30 mm across.

## Distinguishing Features

It is distinguished from the often co-occurring South Coast Donkey Orchid (Diuris brockmanii) by its later flowering period, larger more colourful flowers and longer <u>labellum midlobe</u>.
