## Distribution and Habitat

North east of Eneabba, growing in sandy-clay and clay soils along the edges of natural springs.

## Flowering Months

## Description

A geographically restricted **species** 200–300 mm high with two to three smooth **basal** leaves 100–130 mm long by 1–2 mm wide and up to five yellow, brown marked flowers 10–12 mm across.

## Distinguishing Features

It is related to Bee Orchid (*Diuris laxiflora*) with which it often grows but has smaller flowers and a later flowering period.
