Eneabba to north of Dongara, growing in sandy soils in woodlands and shrublands.

## Description

A distinctive dark flowered [species](#) 200–300 mm high with two to three smooth leaves 120–200 mm long by 4–8 mm wide and up to five rich reddish-brown and yellow flowers 20–25 mm across.

## Distinguishing Features

It often grows in the same area as Dainty Donkey Orchid (*Diuris refracta*) and Early Donkey Orchid (*D. perialla*) but has darker coloured flowers and flowers after those [species](#) have finished.
