## Distribution and Habitat

Esperance to Balladonia, growing in soil pockets on granite outcrops. Its distribution overlaps with the subsp. *undulatus* northeast of Esperance but they occupy different [habitat](#) with *undulatus* found in surrounding woodlands.

## Description

An eastern [subspecies](#) 140–350 mm high with a smooth margined leaf 20–55 mm long by 5–10 mm wide and up to eight white, dull green and red flowers 10–12 mm across.

## Distinguishing Features

It is distinguished from the similar subsp. *dilatatus* by its usually shorter leaf and granite outcrop [habitat](#) east and north-east of Esperance.
