Distribution and Habitat

Roleystone area, growing in gravelly soils in forests. The [species](#) does not appear to require summer fire to flower.

Description

A late autumn-early winter flowering [species](#) 60–210 mm high with an often red backed leaf 8–15 mm long by 2–6 mm wide and up to three (rarely four) white, dull green and red flowers 9–14 mm across.

Distinguishing Features

It has in the past been placed with Common Bunny Orchid (*Eriochilus dilatatus* subsp. *multiflorus*) but has a smaller, often hairy, red backed leaf and a later flowering period.
