Robert Brown in *Prodromus florae Novae Hollandiae et insulae Van-Diemen, exhibens characteres plantarum quas annis 1802-1805: 325* (1810) as *Caladenia menziesii*

Distribution and Habitat

Port Gregory to Israelite Bay, growing in sandy, sandy-clay and lateritic soils in forests, woodlands and shrublands, flowering predominantly in the season following summer fire.

Flowering Months

Description

A **colony** forming **species** 100–300 mm high with one or two smooth leaves 60–100 mm long by 25–30 mm wide and up to five red and white flowers 10–15 mm across.
