Description

Microtis <u>species</u> have a smooth tubular leaf, a smooth flowering stem and up to a 100 small, sweetly scented, green, yellow, red or white flowers in an erect <u>spike</u>. Microtis flowers are similar in shape to those of Leek Orchids (Prasophyllum) but are not inverted and are generally smaller and less colourful. The leaf of most Microtis <u>species</u> is also wholly green or yellowish-green rather than green or purple with a reddish base.
