## Distribution and Habitat

Broke Inlet to Albany, growing in peaty soils in seasonally wet flats, flowering only in the season following a summer fire.

## Flowering Months

Jan . . . . . Dec

## Description

A rare [species](#) 180–350 mm high with a smooth tubular leaf 80–150 mm long by 2–4 mm wide and up to 35 yellowish-green flowers 2–3 mm across.

## Distinguishing Features

It is distinguished from all other members of the *Microtis media* [complex](#) by its incurved [petals](#) and [sepals](#) and very broad [sepals](#).
