Description

Nervilia <u>species</u> are <u>clonal</u> with the stem <u>tuber</u> producing one or more replacement daughter tubers each year. The leaves are pleated or prominently veined (hence the <u>genus</u> name) and are produced after flowering. The flowers are usually short-lived with seed development occurring rapidly following pollination.
