### Distribution and Habitat

Kalamunda to Roleystone, growing in lateritic soils in open forests.

### Description

A recently named *species* 50–100 mm high with a broad, smooth leaf 10–20 mm long by 5–8 mm wide and one (rarely two) inverted, greenish-yellow and red flowers 6–9 mm across. The leaf is usually withered at the time of flowering.

### Distinguishing Features

In the *type* location it grows with Brockman's Duck Orchid (*Paracaleana brockmanii*) but begins flowering a few weeks earlier and has smaller flowers with *calli* confined to the *apical* half rather than third.
