

## Paracaleana nigrita

### Name and Authority

**Paracaleana nigrita** (J.Drumm. ex Lindl.) Blaxell

### Common Name

Flying Duck Orchid

### Complex Name

Paracaleana nigrita (Flying Duck Orchids)

### Originally Described by

James Drummond ex John Lindley in A Sketch of the Vegetation of the Swan River Colony: liv (1840) as Caleana nigrita

### Distribution and Habitat

Mingenew to Condolingup, growing in sandy soils in forests, woodlands and shrublands and more rarely in moss swards on granite rocks.

### Flowering Months

..... Aug Sep Oct ..

### Description

A common **species** 50–150 mm high with a broad, smooth leaf 10–30 mm long by 7–11 mm wide and one (rarely two) inverted, greenish-yellow and red flowers 6–8 mm across.

### Distinguishing Features

It is distinguished from the related Hort's Duck Orchid (*Paracaleana hortiorum*) by its shorter, broader, more prominently humped **labellum**. Where the two **species** grow together it is in late flower when *P. hortiorum* is in early flower.
