Distribution and Habitat

Gibson to Israelite Bay, growing in deep sand in shrublands.

Flowering Months

..... Oct Nov

Description

A small flowered species 90–180 mm high with broad, smooth leaf 10–30 mm long by 3–5 mm wide and one (rarely two) inverted, greenish-yellow and red flowers 4–6 mm across. The leaf is usually withered at the time of flowering.

Distinguishing Features

It is distinguished from Little Duck Orchid (*Paracaleana disjuncta*) with which it sometimes grows by its smaller flowers and shorter labellum with the calli confined to the tip.
