## Description

A recently recognised <u>species</u> 70–150 mm high with a broad, smooth leaf 20–30 mm long by 6–9 mm wide and one (rarely two) inverted, greenish-yellow and red flowers 8–10 mm across.

## Distinguishing Features

It is closely related to Alcock's Duck Orchid (Paracaleana alcockii) but has an earlier flowering period and a less prominently humped <u>labellum</u> with <u>calli</u> confined to the <u>apical</u> quarter to third, rather than a third to half.
