East of Geraldton to Eurary Station, growing in sandy soils in shrublands.

Description

A northern *species* 80–140 mm high with broad, smooth leaf 20–30 mm long by 5–8 mm wide and one (rarely two) inverted, greenish-yellow and red flowers 8–10 mm across.

Distinguishing Features

It is distinguished from Alcock's Duck Orchid (*Paracaleana alcockii*) and Northampton Duck Orchid (*P. sp. 'Northampton'*) which share the same northerly distribution by its *lamina calli* which are fewer in number and confined to the tip of the *labellum*.
