## Description

A distinctive <u>species</u> 60–140 mm high with a broad, smooth leaf 15–30 mm long by 5–10 mm wide and one (rarely two) inverted, greenish-yellow and red flowers 8–10 mm across.

## Distinguishing Features

It is distinguished from Brockman's Duck Orchid (Paracaleana brockmanii) by its fresh rather than shrivelled leaf when flowering, smaller flowers and earlier flowering period.
