Phoringopsis <u>species</u> have one or two long, semi-erect leaves and a multi-flowered <u>raceme</u> of insignificant inverted, dull-coloured flowers with a prominent insect-like <u>labellum</u>. The cryptic nature of the flowers means that it is often easier to locate plants by searching for the distinctive leaves which are often found growing in colonies as a result of vegetative reproduction.
