Description

A rare <u>species</u> 50–250 mm high with a smooth tubular leaf 100–150 mm long by 3–6 mm wide and up to 60 sweetly fragrant, green and white flowers 6–8 mm across.

Distinguishing Features

It is distinguished from the other members of the Prasophyllum cucullatum <u>complex</u> by its green and white flowers and more northerly distribution.
