## Pterostylis microglossa

### Name and Authority

### Distribution and Habitat

Zuytdorf Cliffs to Jurien Bay, growing in sandy soils in coastal woodlands and shrublands. The *species* is particularly common in soil pockets in areas of exposed limestone.

### Flowering Months

### Description

A northern *species* 50–120 mm high with four to six *cauline* leaves 10–30 mm long by 3–6 mm wide and one (rarely two) translucent, dull green (more rarely brown) and white flowers 8–10 mm across.

### Distinguishing Features

It is distinguished from the related Brown-veined Orchid (*Pterostylis aspera*) by its smaller flowers and northerly distribution.
