## Distribution and Habitat

Whicher Range, growing in sand over laterite in forests and shrublands.

## Flowering Months

## Description

A restricted **species** 50–140 mm high with three to five **cauline** leaves 16–23 mm long by 3–4 mm wide and up to three translucent olive-green and white or brown and white flowers 3–5 mm across.

## Distinguishing Features

It is distinguished from the closely related Little Frog Greenhood (*Pterostylis occulta*) by the **papillate**, upper lobes of the **labellum**, smaller flowers and toothed **petal** inferior margins.
