Karridale, growing in sandy soils in woodlands and shrublands.

Description

A little-known **species** 100–200 mm high with a loose, ascending **rosette** of leaves 10–25 mm across, two to four **cauline** leaves and one (rarely two) translucent, light green and white flowers 7–9 mm across.

Distinguishing Features

It is distinguished from the related Bearded Bird Orchid (*Pterostylis turfosa*) by its smaller flowers.
