## Distribution and Habitat

Karonie, growing in soil pockets on granite outcrops and in deeper soil in surrounding shrublands.

## Flowering Months

## Description

A rare eastern [species](#) 200–350 mm high with eight to 10 leaves forming a ground-hugging [basal rosette](#) 35–70 mm across and up to eight large, translucent, fawn and white flowers 12–16 mm across.

## Distinguishing Features

It is distinguished from the co-occurring Rock-loving Rufous Greenhood (*Pterostylis xerampelina*) by its larger fawn coloured flowers and longer less prominently falcate [lateral sepals](#).
