Distribution and Habitat

Dardanup to Israelite Bay, growing in sandy soils in forests, woodlands and shrublands. In some areas it occupies shallow soil pockets on granite outcrops.

Description

A southern *species* 100–200 mm high with a loose, ascending *rosette* of leaves 12–35 mm across, two to four *cauline* leaves and one (rarely two) translucent, light green and white flowers 9–11 mm across.



Pterostylis turfosa

Distinguishing Features

It is distinguished from Late Bird Orchid (*Pterostylis serotina*) by its less bloated appearance, thinner *sepals* and generally earlier flowering period.
