## Description

Rhizanthella <u>species</u> are remarkable in that they spend their <u>entire</u> life cycle, including flowering, below the soil surface, this feature making them unique among the world's orchids. The two <u>species</u> found in Western Australia produce up to 100 small, inward facing flowers, surrounded by large floral bracts which curve over the flowers. Each plant has a horizontal <u>rhizome</u> 60–120 mm below the ground level which, like the rest of the plant, is succulent.
