Distribution and Habitat

Shark Bay to Israelite Bay, growing on creek margins, seasonally moist flats and granite outcrops.

Flowering Months

Description

A common, **colony**-forming **species** 100–250 mm high with a narrow, smooth leaf 80–150 mm long by 2–3 mm wide and up to four lemon-yellow, lemon-scented flowers 20–30 mm across.

Distinguishing Features

It is distinguished from the other yellow flowered Thelymitra **species** in Western Australia by its distinctive **column** with a yellow forward projecting mid **lobe** and reddish-brown ear-like **lateral** lobes.
