Distribution and Habitat

Nerren Nerren Station to Bunbury and eastwards to Israelite Bay, growing in sandy soils in woodlands and shrublands.

Flowering Months

Description

A common **species** 200–500 mm high with a narrow, smooth leaf 100–150 mm long by 3–5 mm wide and up to 15 pink, mauve or purple, prominently striped, slightly cupped flowers 20–25 mm across.

Distinguishing Features

It is distinguished from other members of the **complex** by its more broadly-striped, cupped flowers.
